DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

St. Luke's Lutheran Church Cemetery contains a total of some 300 gravestones, of which about 50 are of local manufacture. The earliest inscribed gravestone has a death date of 1804. The small number of early gravestones and the fact that none of the major styles of gravestone carving are represented with the exception of one gravestone by the Swisegood School and three stones by the "Master of the Upper and Lower Case" indicates that the congregation was small and outside the range of activity of most of the stonecutting workshops. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

John Adam Swicegood (1752-1833) deeded land for the first church building in 1790, known as Sandy Creek Lutheran Church. A few years later, the church moved to the present site and was renamed St. Luke's.¹



CRITERIA ASSESSMENT

A,C Derives primary significance from the unique collection of folk gravestones by local stonecutters erected here in the late eighteenth and first half of the nineteenth centuries. These highly decorative soapstone gravestones with folk symbols for resurrection and eternity represent the height of folk art accomplishment within the craft community of the Anglo-German farmers of north Davidson County.

Contains a small but significant collection of markers dating from the early nineteenth century by amateur stonecutters largely unaffected by the major stonecutting workshops in Davidson County.
